Welcome to GEL Futsal Season 2 | 2025

GEL Futsal is an exciting social competition committed to delivering high-quality futsal for teams of all skills and experiences. We run men's and mixed competitions with multiple divisions to ensure every team gets the best experience possible.

GEL Futsal Season 2, 2025 commences Tuesday, 29 April and consists of four grading games, 15 rounds and a two week finals series.

Tuesday Night Competition

GEL Futsal takes place on Tuesday nights and offers men's and mixed competitions.

- The men's competition will feature 1-3 divisions.
- The mixed competition will feature 1-2 divisions.

Timeslots

Match timeslots are 40 minutes long, starting at 6:30 pm and finishing at 10:30 pm.

Tuesday Timeslots: 6:30 pm, 7:10 pm, 7:50 pm, 8:30 pm, 9:10 pm & 9:50 pm

Fixturing Terms

- By entering a GEL Futsal competition, teams agree to play any time slot.
- Teams will receive a warning for any 9:50 pm matches that they forfeit.
- Teams may accumulate two warnings per season before a team suspension is applied.
- We cannot guarantee an even spread of timeslots.
- We reserve the right to remove teams who continue to forfeit their matches. In this scenario, players/team fees will be forfeited.
- Please consider the above notes before registering for the season.

Competition Fees

The City of Glen Eira determines GEL Futsal competition fees.

Registration Fee	Early Bird Special	Weekly Match Fee	Upfront Season Fee

- The Early Bird special offer expires end of day Friday, 18 April 2025.
- Teams must pay the registration fee to secure a spot in the competition.
- Teams must pay the season fee upfront OR pay weekly match fees.
- Teams electing to pay weekly must make match payments before each match via GESAC's customer service desk.
- For teams paying weekly, the team captain will be given a match payment receipt which must be handed to the referee before the match begins.
- Season fees and weekly match fees are not inclusive of finals match fees.
- Teams who elect to pay weekly are subject to a \$94.50 forfeit fee.
- Teams who elect to pay upfront are not entitled to a refund if they forfeit a match.

Code of Conduct

By registering, players agree to adhere to the GEL Codes of Conduct (Captain, Player, and Spectator).

- **Breaching conduct rules** may result in warnings, yellow or red cards being issued or being suspended or banned from GEL Futsal competitions.
- Failure to follow the umpires' or Futsal supervisors' instructions can result in the game being abandoned and the offending team deemed to have lost on forfeit.
- Additionally, at our discretion, we have the right to suspend or immediately remove players and teams from the competition. In this scenario, players/team fees will be forfeited.

Forfeits & Refunds

Teams registering for GEL Futsal commit to the season and associated fees. Please review the full refund and forfeit terms in the competition rules document.

Overview - Forfeits

- If your team cannot fill a team or attend a match, you must notify GEL Competition Management that your team needs to forfeit.
- Teams that forfeit must still pay for the forfeited match, no matter how much notice is given.
- The forfeited fee will be added to the following match fee.
- An automatic forfeit will apply if a team is not on the court within 10 minutes of the fixtured start time.
- If a team forfeits without sufficient notification (at least 24 hours prior to the time of the fixture), GESAC's competition management reserves the right to remove the team from the competition.

Overview - Refunds

- If a team that has paid upfront is on the receiving end of a forfeit, they will be credited or refunded at the discretion of GESAC's competition management.
- The match fee of the team receiving the forfeit will not be payable, and if it has been paid, it will be credited or refunded at the discretion of GESAC's competition management.
- If a team withdraws from the competition for any reason after the commencement of the competition and prior to the end of the competition, it will not be entitled to a refund or any part of its registration fee.
- If GESAC's competition management suspends or withdraws a team from the competition for any reason, no refund of the registration fee or upfront match fees will be refunded.
