They are larger than standard accessible toilets designed to meet the needs of people with high support needs and their carers.

You can also find the nearest Changing Places facility (and other Adult Change facilities) on the National Public Toilet Map website or **using the app**.

**MLAK**  
Master Locksmiths Access Key

Many Changing Places are fitted with a key-operated system using an MLAK key available from the Master Locksmiths Association [masterlocksmiths.com.au](https://masterlocksmiths.com.au)

Changing Places that use the MLAK are more likely to be kept clean and provide a safe environment for the people who use them.

To find out if a Changing Places requires an MLAK, you can check the [changingplaces.org.au](https://changingplaces.org.au) website or the National Public Toilet map website. This will also tell you if you can borrow an MLAK key from the facility owner.
