Welcome to GEL Senior Futsal Season S2 2026

GEL Futsal is an exciting social competition committed to delivering high-quality futsal for teams of all skills and experiences. We run men’s and mixed competitions with multiple divisions to ensure every team gets the best experience possible.

GEL Futsal Season 2 2026 commences Tuesday, 16 June and consists of two grading games, 11 rounds and a two-week finals series.

Tuesday Night Competition

GEL Futsal takes place on Tuesday nights and offers men’s and mixed competitions.

Timeslots

Match timeslots are 40 minutes long, starting at 6:30 pm and finishing at 10:30 pm.

- Tuesday Timeslots: 6:30 pm, 7:10 pm, 7:50 pm, 8:30 pm, 9:10 pm & 9:50 pm

Fixturing Terms

- By entering a GEL Futsal competition, teams agree to play any time slot.
- Teams will receive a warning for any matches that they forfeit.
- Teams may accumulate two warnings per season before a team suspension is applied.
- We cannot guarantee an even spread of timeslots.
- We reserve the right to remove teams who continue to forfeit their matches. In this scenario, players/team fees will be forfeited.
- Please consider the above notes before registering for the season.

- *The Early Bird special offer expires at 11:59 pm on Tuesday, 30th June.
- Teams can pay the Early Bird registration fee, then pay matches weekly at set rate.
- Season fees and weekly match fees are not inclusive of finals match fees.
- Teams can pay the season's fee upfront or weekly.
- Teams electing to pay weekly must make match payments before each match via GESAC's customer service desk.
- The team captain must give the match payment receipt to the umpire before the match begins.

Code of Conduct

By registering, players agree to adhere to the GEL Codes of Conduct (Captain, Player, and Spectator).

- **Breaching conduct rules** may result in warnings, yellow or red cards being issued or being suspended or banned from GEL Futsal competitions.
- Failure to follow the umpires' or Futsal supervisors' instructions can result in the game being abandoned and the offending team deemed to have lost on forfeit.
- Additionally, at our discretion, we have the right to suspend or immediately remove players and teams from the competition. In this scenario, players/team fees will be forfeited.

Forfeits & Refunds

Teams registering for GEL Futsal commit to the season including finals and associated fees. Please review the full refund and forfeit terms in the competition rules document.

Overview – Forfeits

- If your team cannot field a team or attend a match, you must notify GEL Competition Management that your team needs to forfeit.

Teams that forfeit will incur a forfeit fee and is based on notice given:

- More than 21 days' notice: 1 x match fee
- Less than 21 days' notice: 1.5 x match fee

This forfeit fee will be payable prior to the next scheduled game or prior to the end of season (whichever is sooner).

- An automatic forfeit will apply if a team is not on the court within 10 minutes of the fixtured start time.
- If a team forfeits without sufficient notification, GESAC's competition management reserves the right to remove the team from the competition.

Overview – Refunds

- If a team that has paid upfront is on the receiving end of a forfeit, they will be credited or refunded at the discretion of GESAC's competition management.
- If a team withdraws from the competition for any reason after the commencement of the competition and prior to the end of the competition, it will not be entitled to a refund of any part of its registration or season fee.
- If GESAC's competition management suspends or withdraws a team from the competition for any reason, no refund of the registration or upfront season fees will be refunded.
